- Washington County's **overall performance is higher than 38% of districts.**
- Its elementary students' **academic growth is higher than 65% of districts.**
- Its middle school students' **academic growth is higher than 56% of districts.**
- Its high school students' **academic growth is higher than 50% of districts.**
- **35.0% of its 3rd grade students are reading at or above the grade level target.**
- **50.5% of its 8th grade students are reading at or above the grade level target.**
- **Its four-year graduation rate is 95.2%, which is higher than 91% of districts.**
- **44.1% of graduates are college and career ready.**

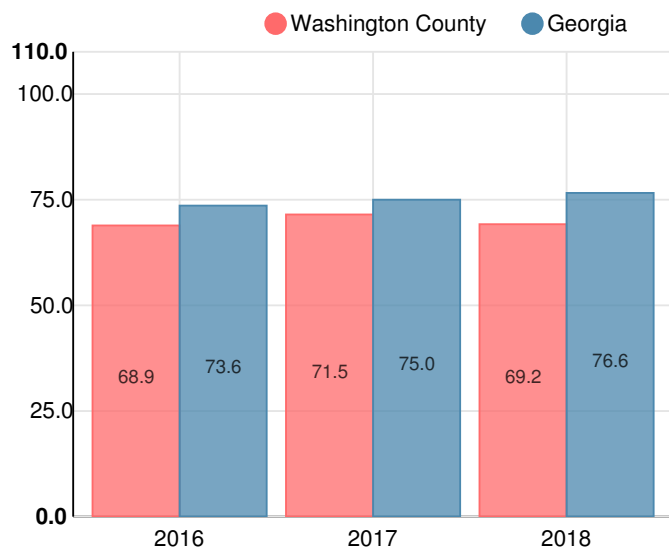

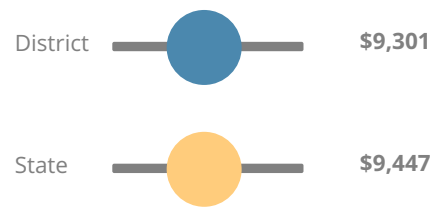

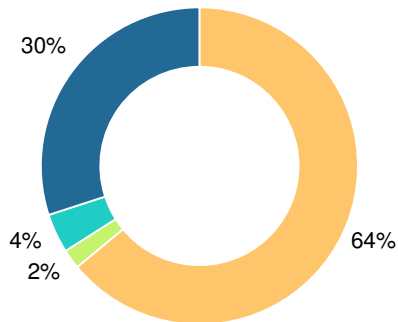


Per Pupil Expenditures

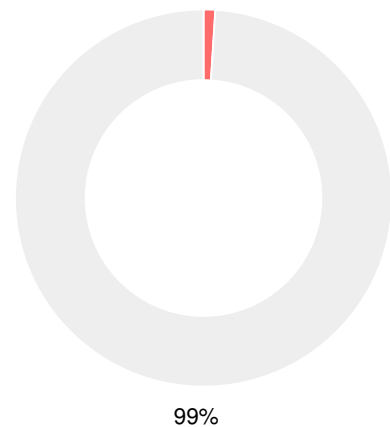

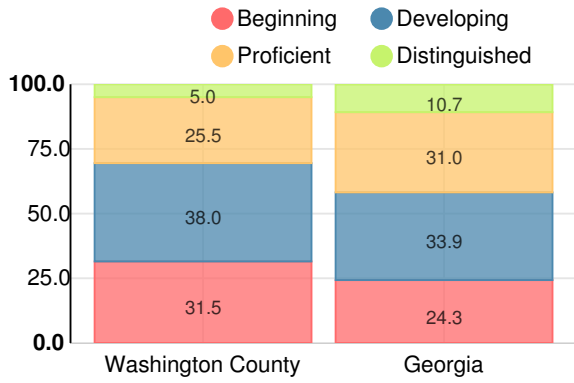

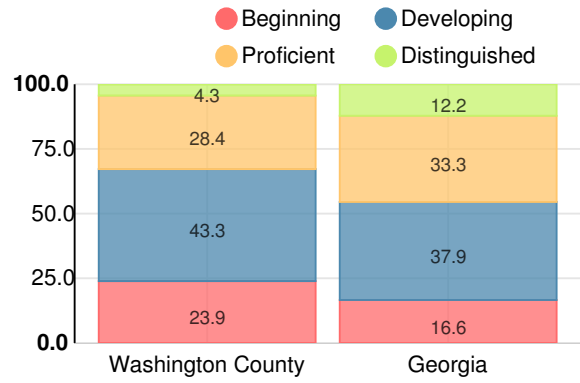

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2018 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



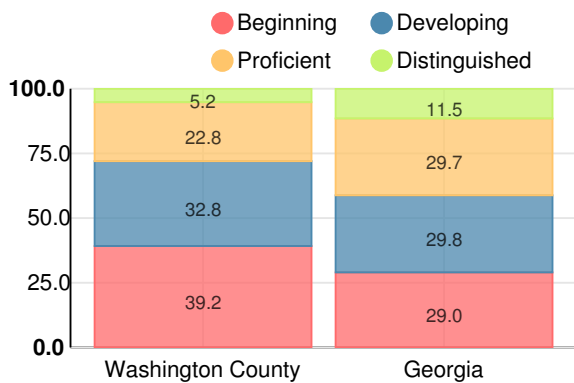
## Mathematics

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2018 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



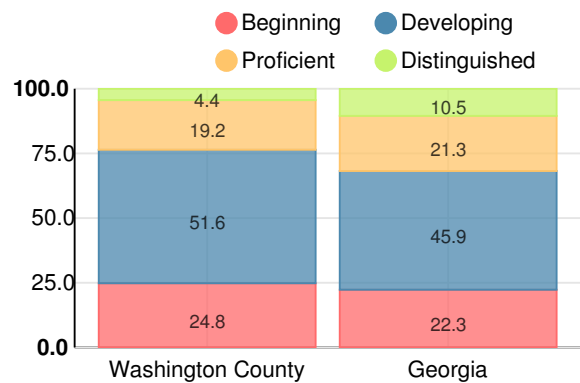

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2018 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



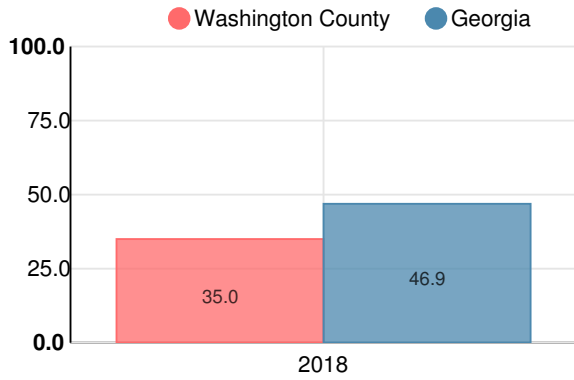

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2018 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



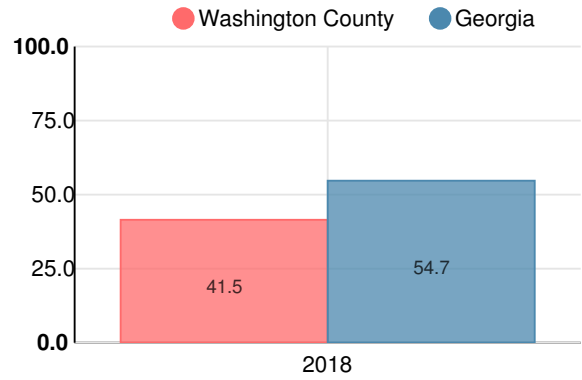
### Reading at or above the Grade Level Target (3rd Grade)

### Reading at or above the Grade Level Target (5th Grade)

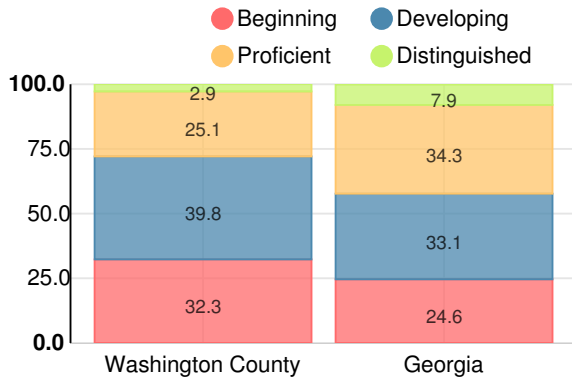
Percent of students in grade 5 achieving Lexile measure equal to or greater than 920

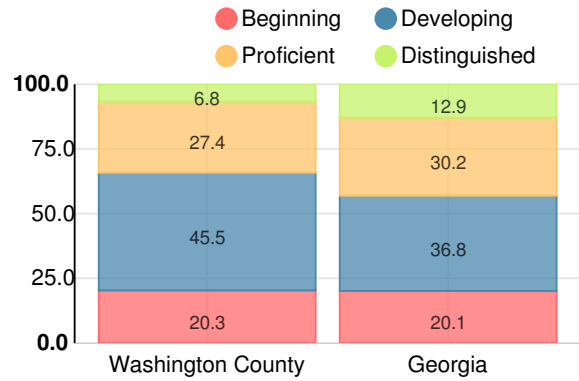

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2018 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



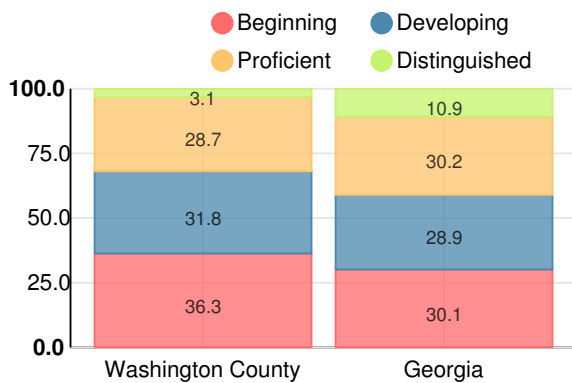
### Mathematics

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2018 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



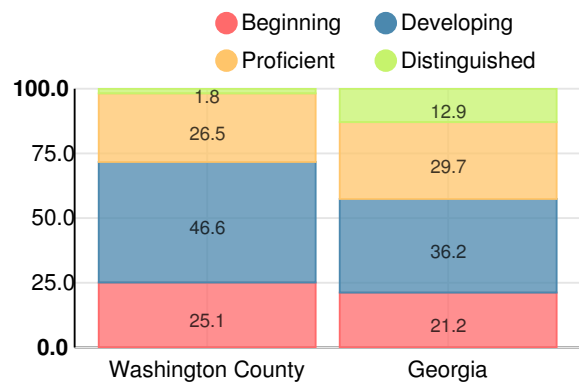

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2018 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



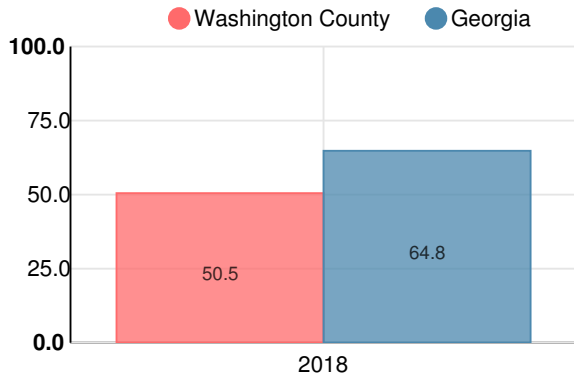

### Reading at or above the Grade Level Target (8th Grade)

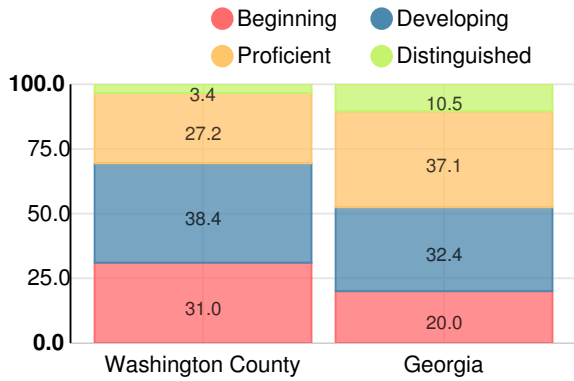
Percent of students in grade 8 achieving Lexile measure greater than 1097

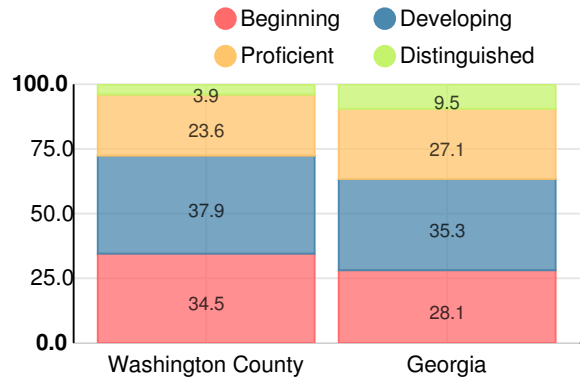

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2018 Georgia Milestones



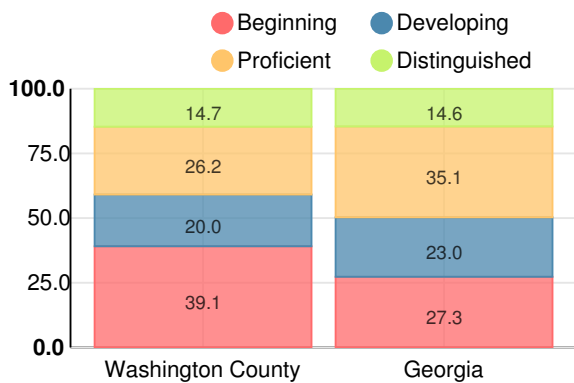
## Coordinate Algebra/Algebra I

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2018 Georgia Milestones



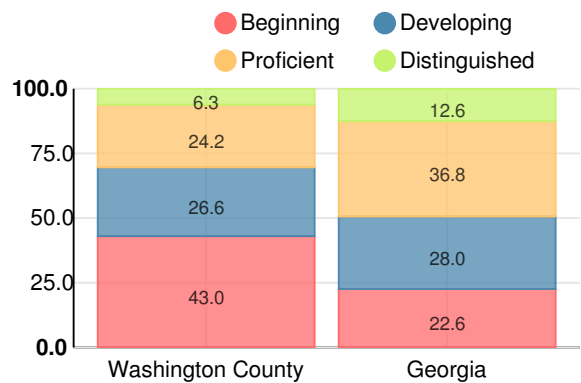

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2018 Georgia Milestones



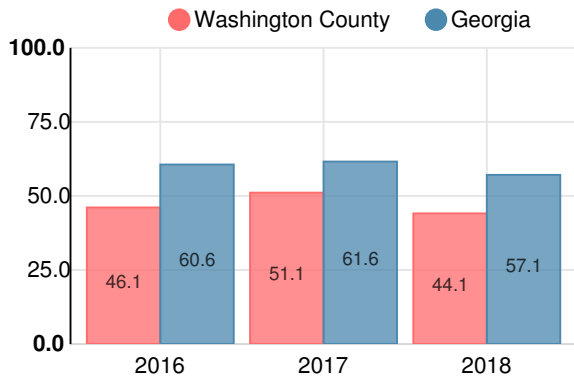
## US History

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2018 Georgia Milestones



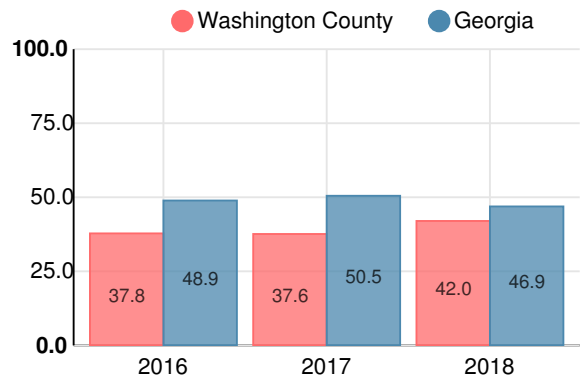
**College & Career Readiness**

Percent of 12th grade students who are college and career ready

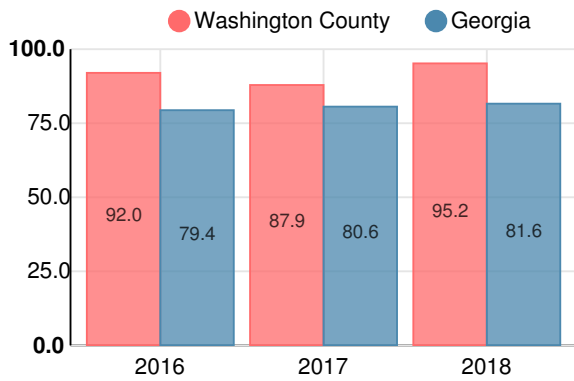


**Accelerated Course Taking**
