





Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades





Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades





Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades





Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades




Reading at or above the Grade Level Target (3rd Grade)

Reading at or above the Grade Level Target (5th Grade)


Percent of students in grade 5 achieving Lexile measure equal to or greater than 920



Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades





Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades





Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades






Percent of students in grade 8 achieving Lexile measure greater than 1097



Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones





Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones




Coordinate Algebra/Algebra I

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones





Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones



Percent of 12th grade students who are college and career ready




Four-Year Graduation Rate
