- Richmond County's **overall performance is higher than 4% of districts.**
- Its elementary students' **academic growth is higher than 46% of districts.**
- Its middle school students' **academic growth is higher than 9% of districts.**
- Its high school students' **academic growth is higher than 21% of districts.**
- **30.1% of its 3rd grade students are reading at or above the grade level target.**
- **50.1% of its 8th grade students are reading at or above the grade level target.**
- **Its four-year graduation rate is 75.1%, which is higher than 3% of districts.**
- **37.8% of graduates are college and career ready.**

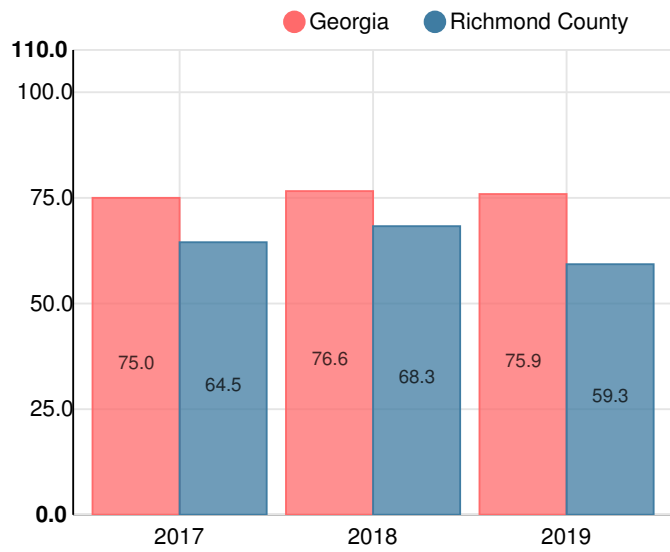

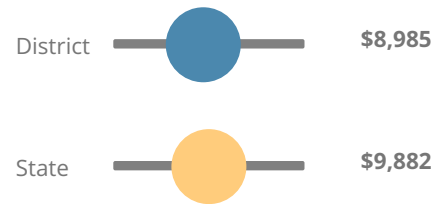

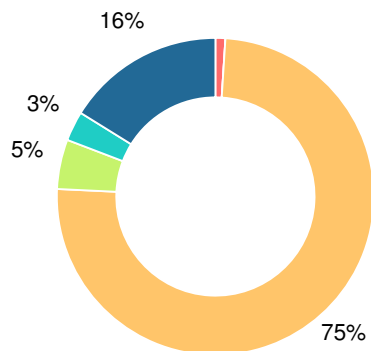


Per Pupil Expenditures

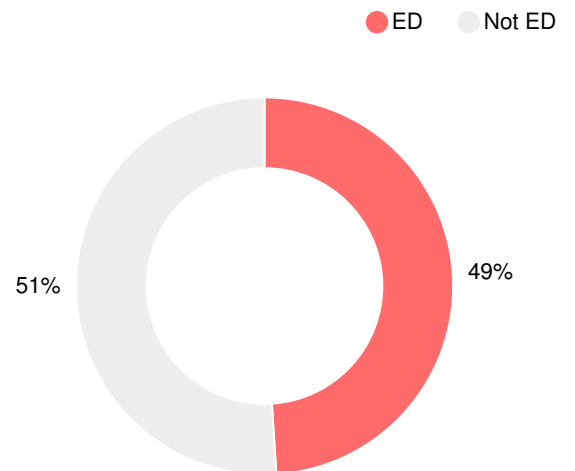

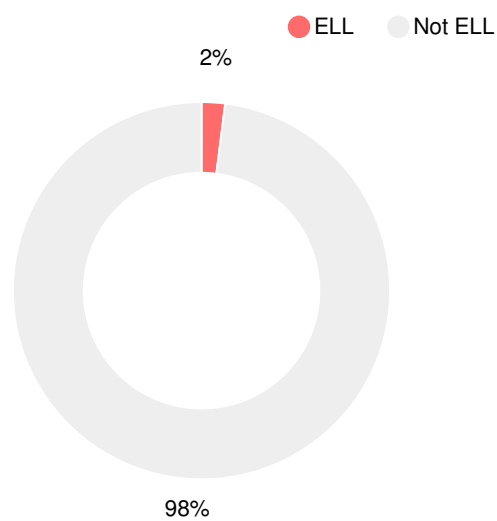

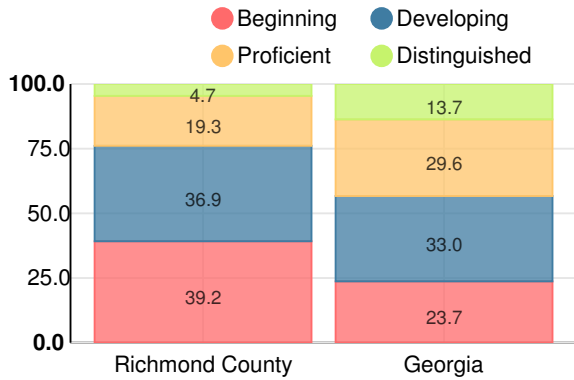

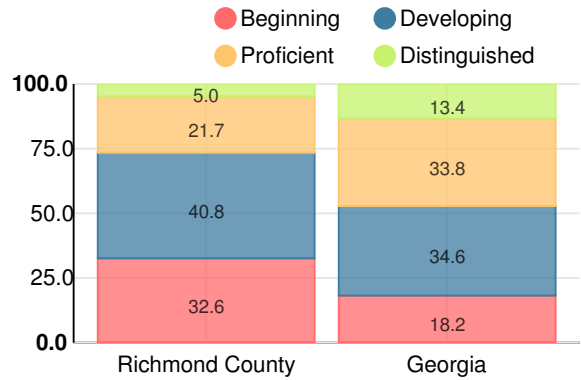

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



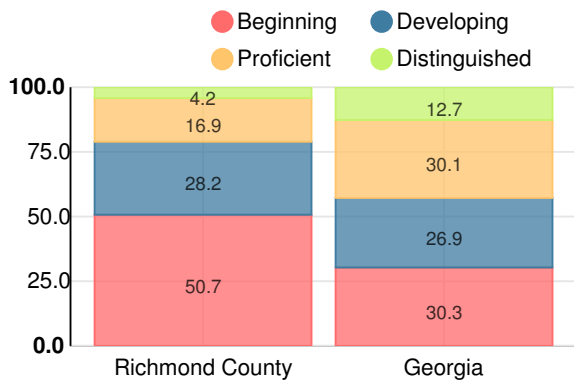

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



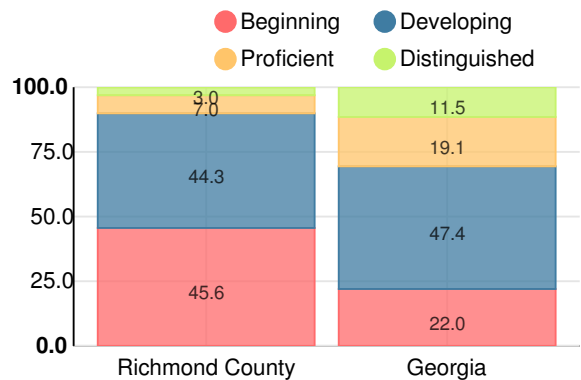

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



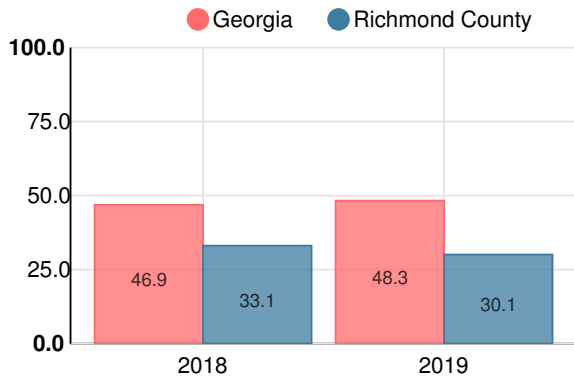

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



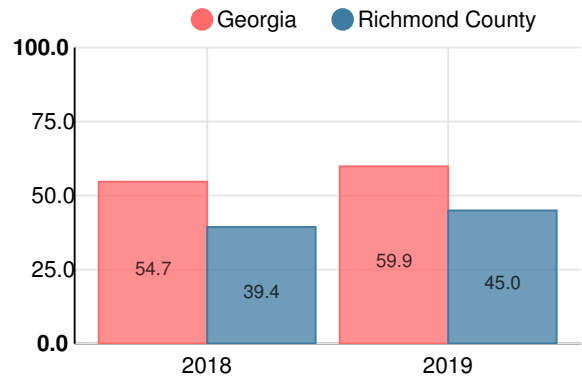

(5th Grade)**

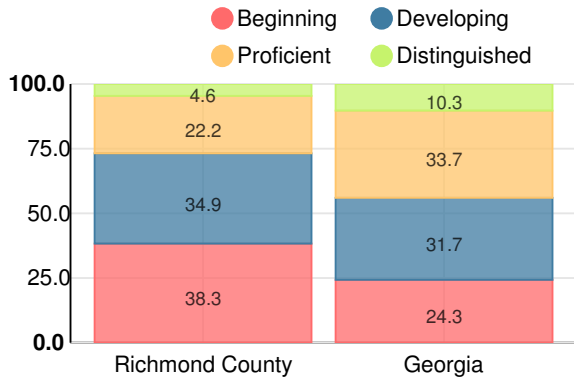
Percent of students in grade 5 achieving Lexile measure equal to or greater than 920

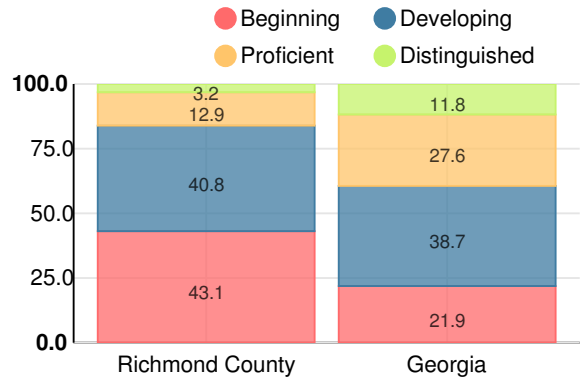

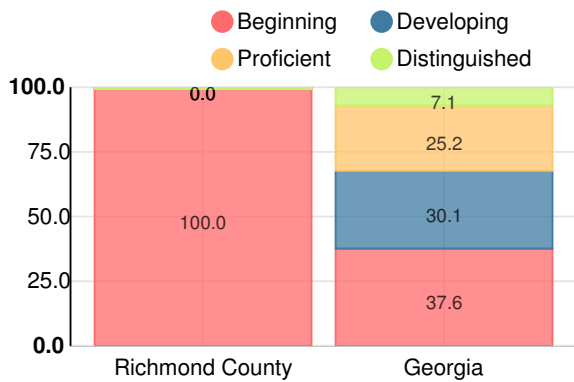

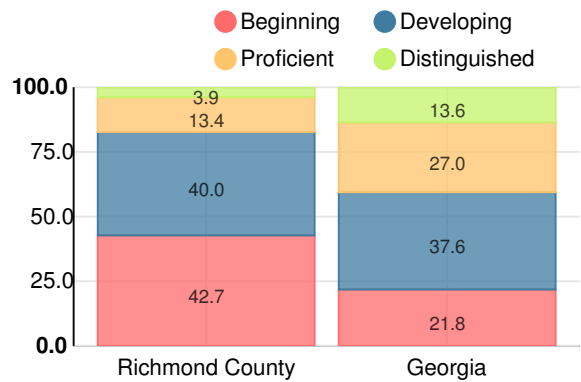

Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



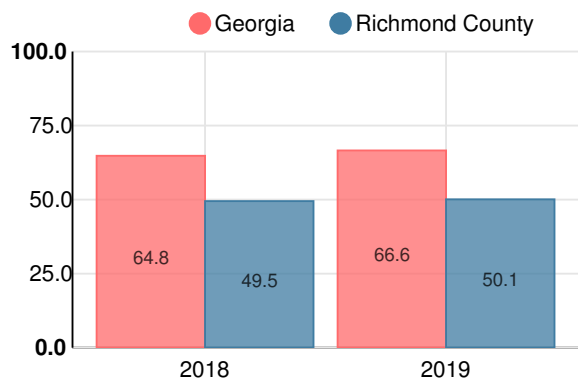

### Reading at or above the Grade Level Target (8th Grade)

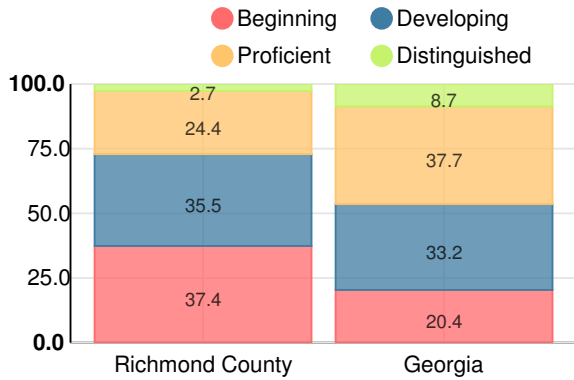
Percent of students in grade 8 achieving Lexile measure greater than 1097

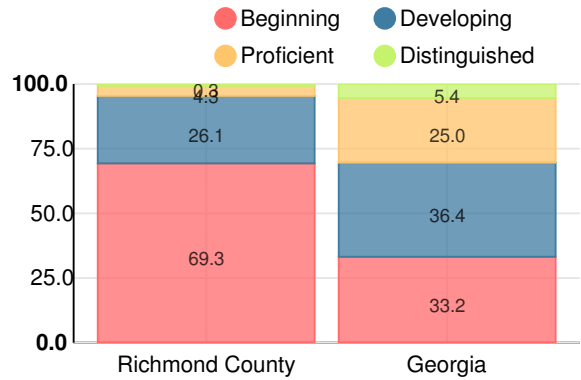

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones



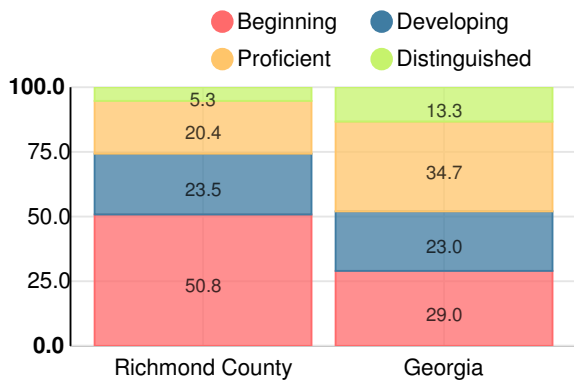
## Coordinate Algebra/Algebra I

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones



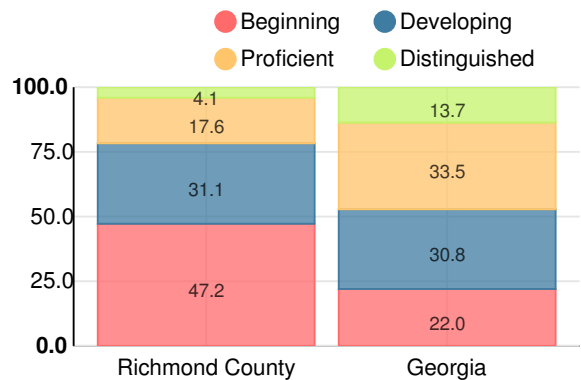

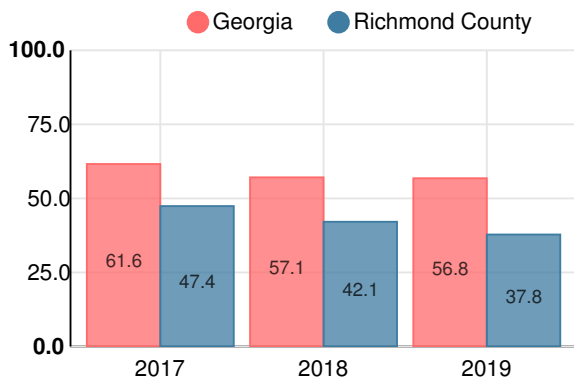
Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones





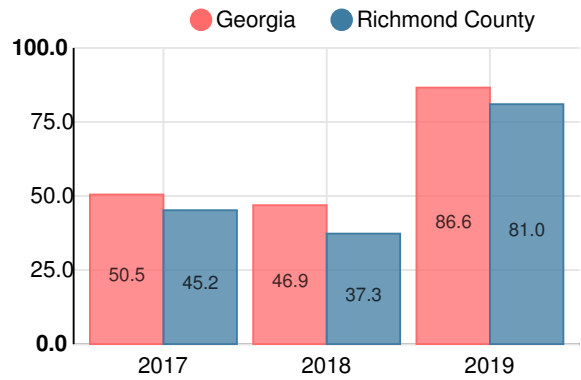
### College & Career Readiness

Percent of 12th grade students who are college and career ready

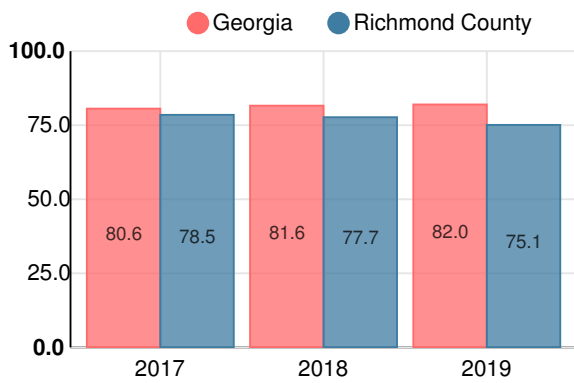


### Accelerated Course Taking
