- **9.3% of its 3rd grade students are reading at or above the grade level target.**

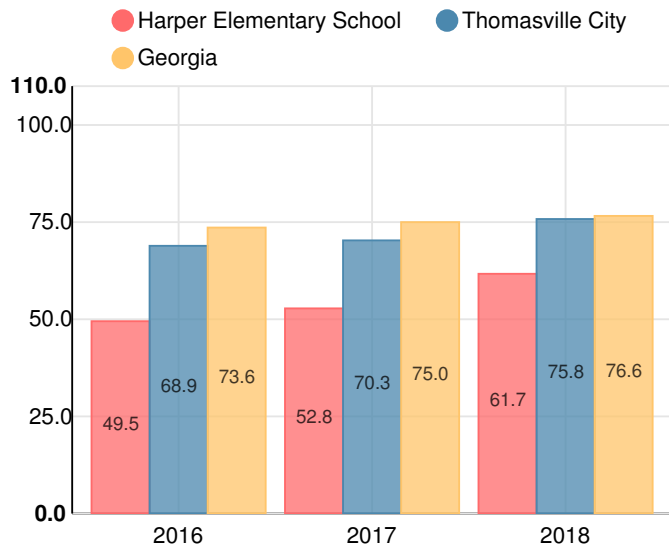

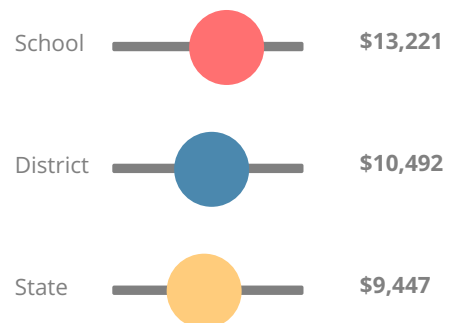

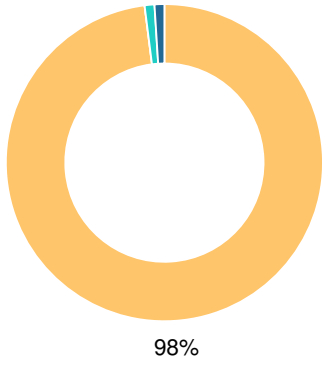


Per Pupil Expenditures



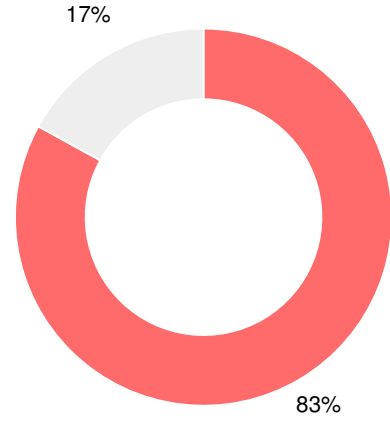

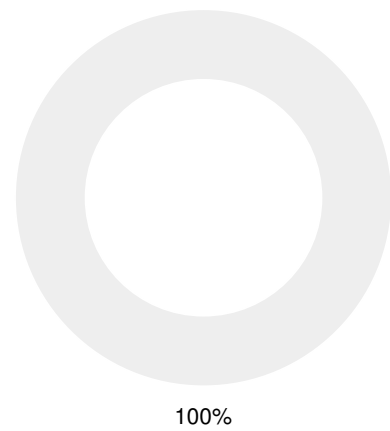

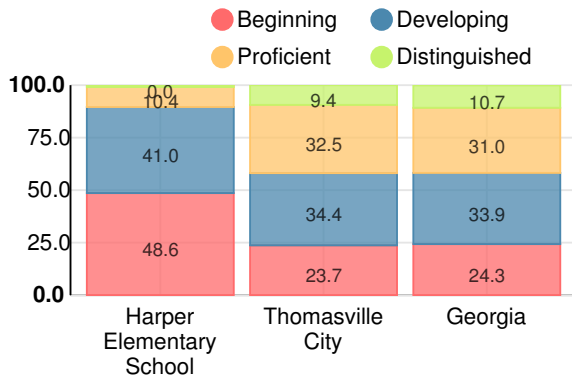

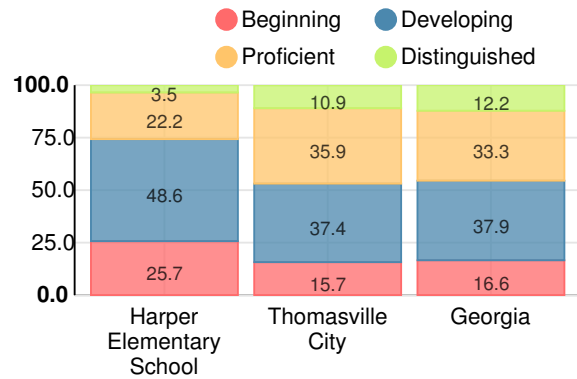

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2018 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



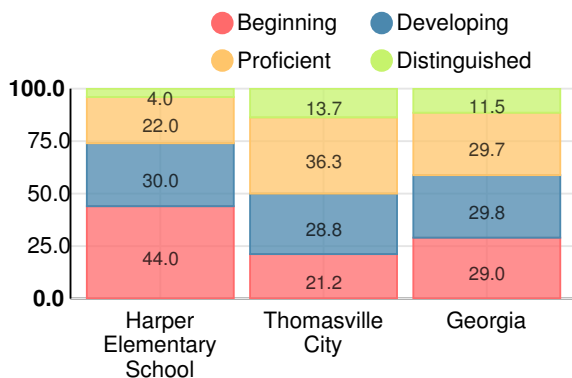

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2018 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



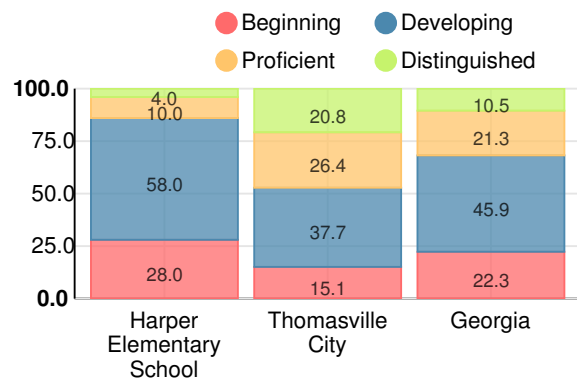

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2018 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



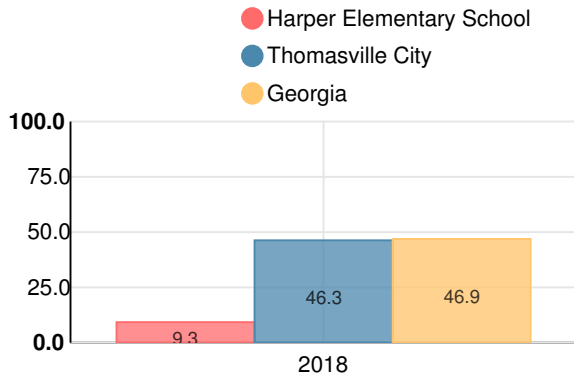
