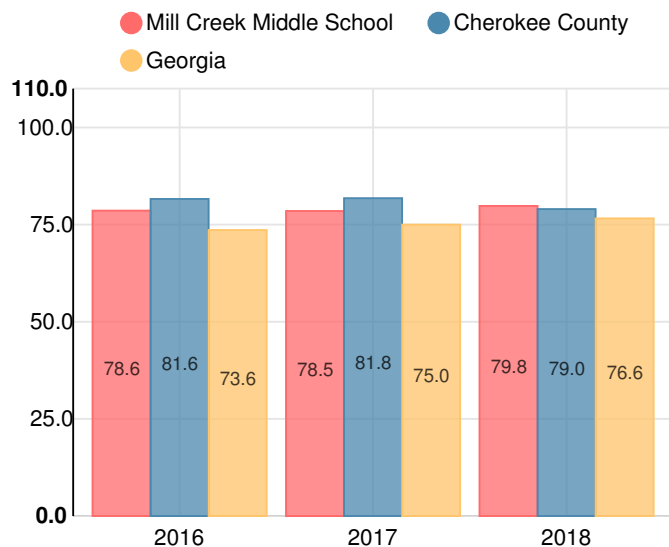

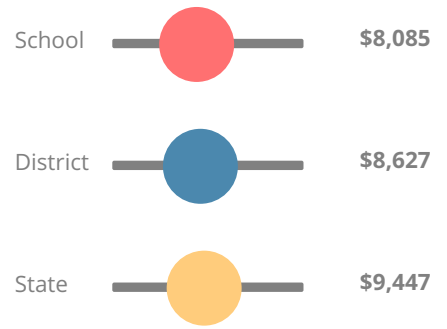
School Climate Star Rating



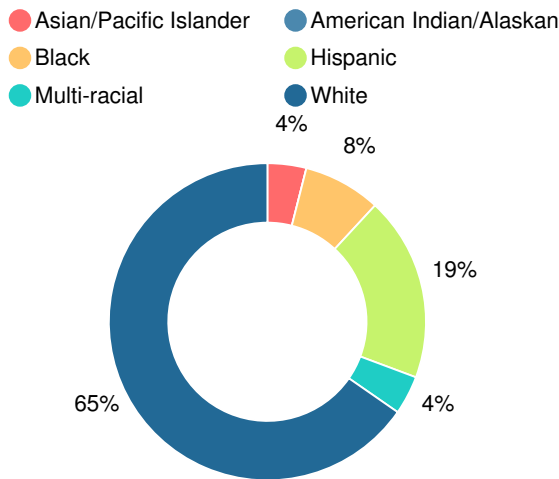
Financial Efficiency Star Rating



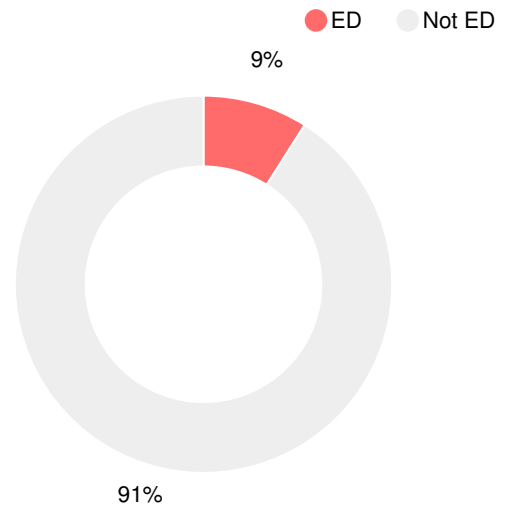
Per Pupil Expenditures



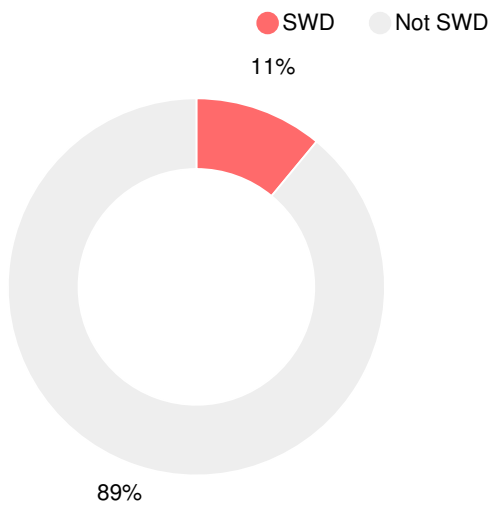

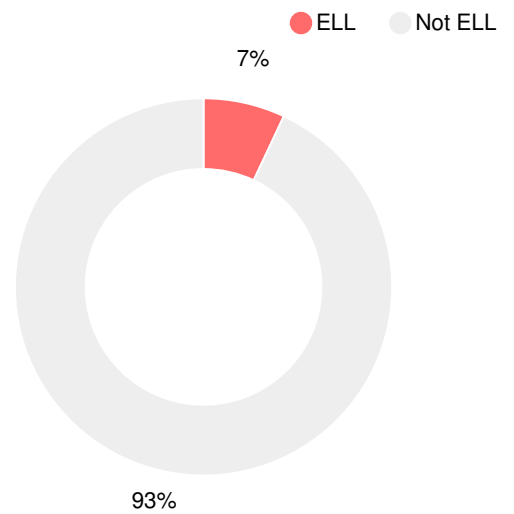

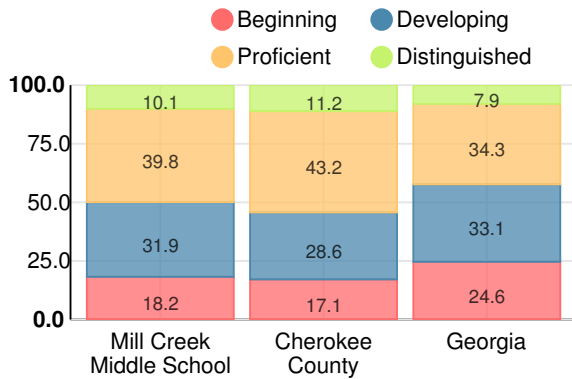

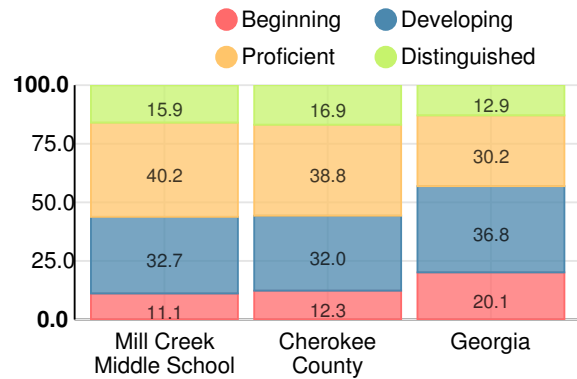

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2018 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



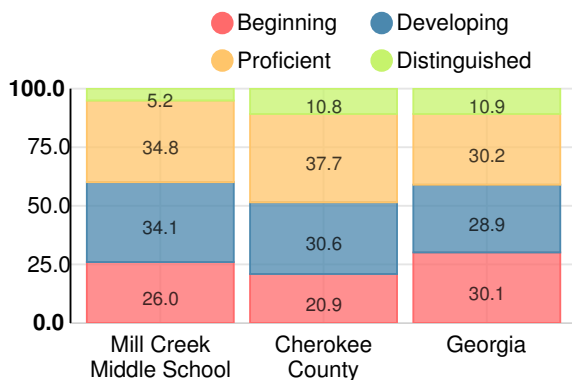

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2018 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



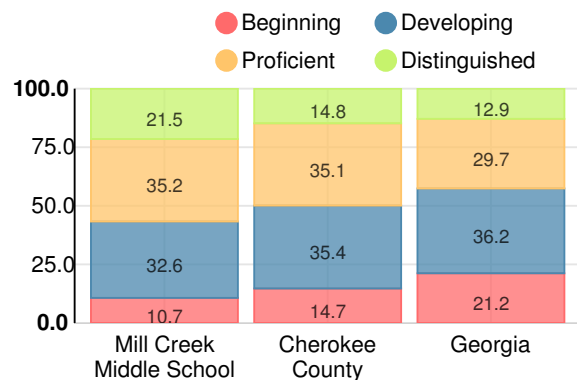
