- **50.0% of its 8th grade students are reading at or above the grade level target.**

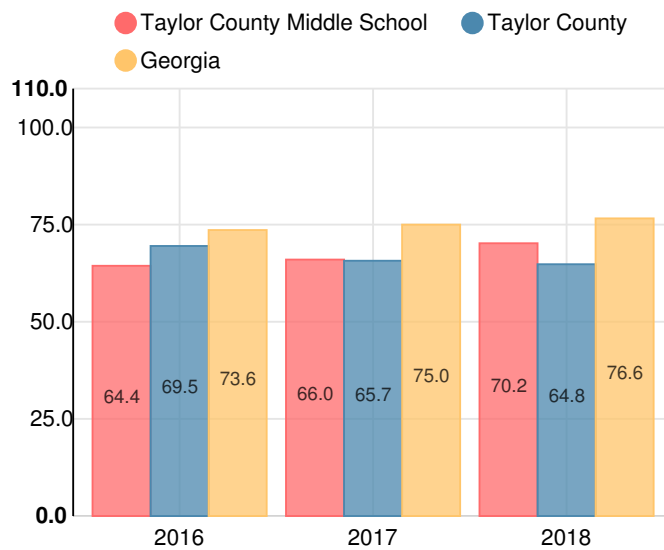

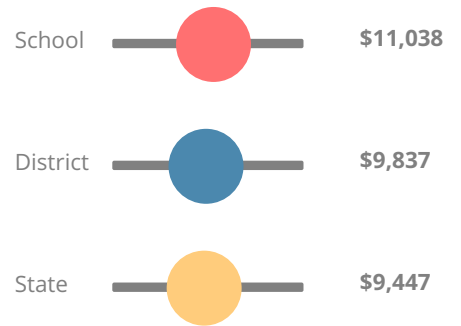

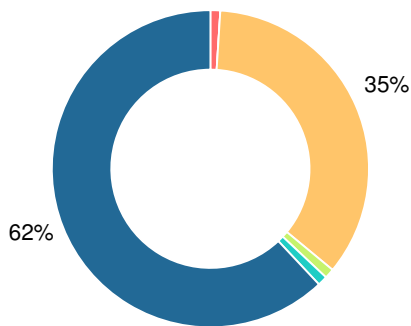


Per Pupil Expenditures



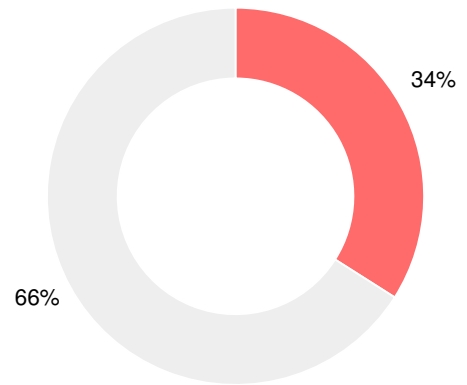

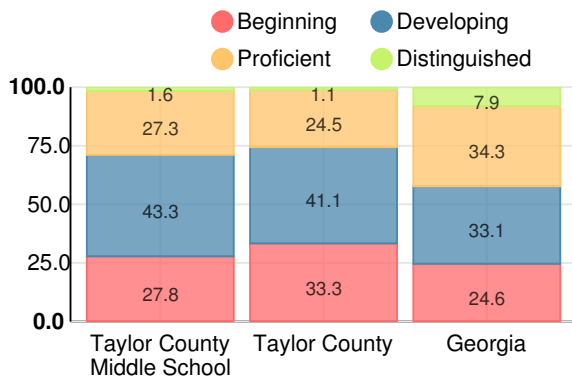

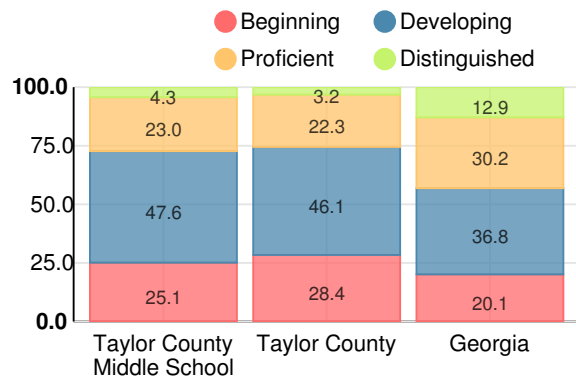

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2018 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



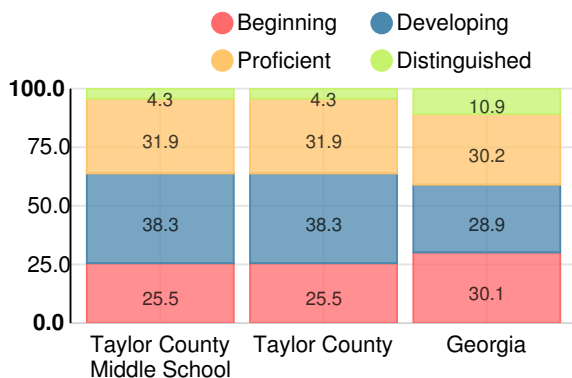
Mathematics

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2018 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



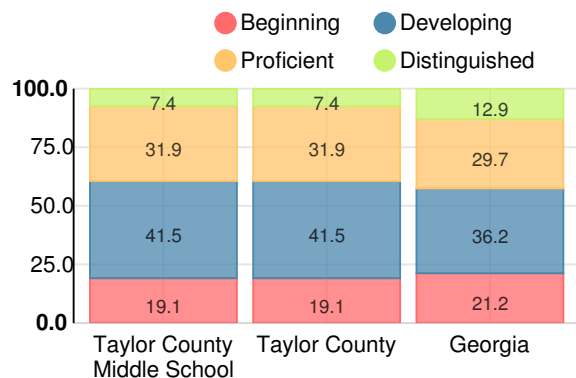
Science
