- Its students' **academic growth is higher than 33% of schools in the state** and lower than its district.

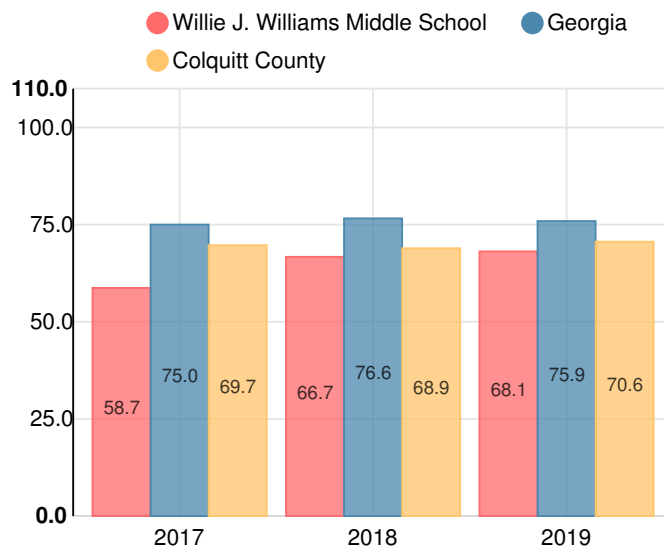

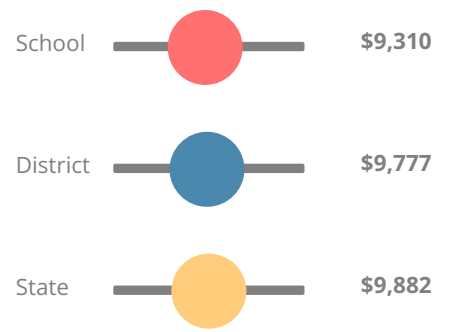

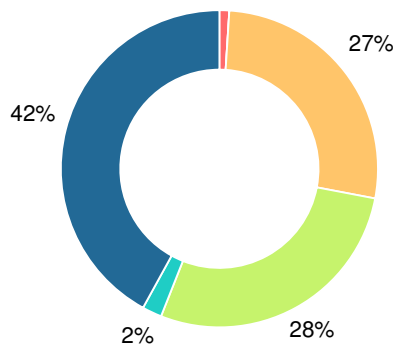


Per Pupil Expenditures



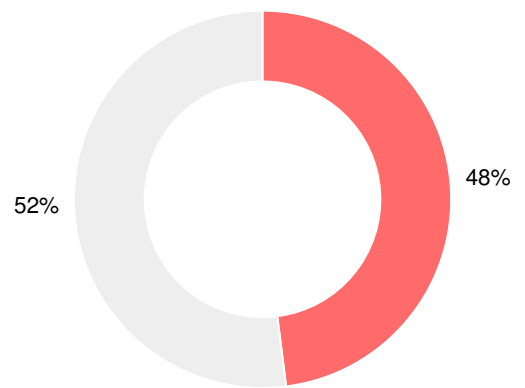

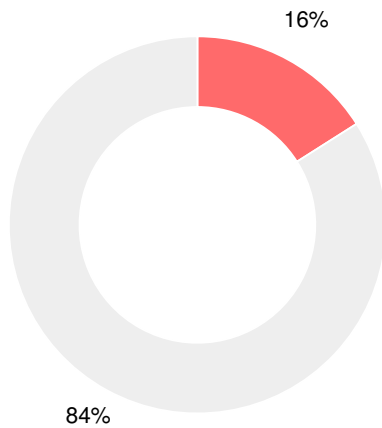

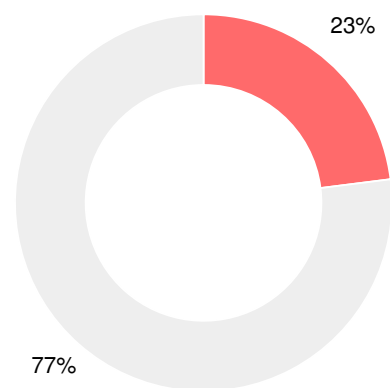

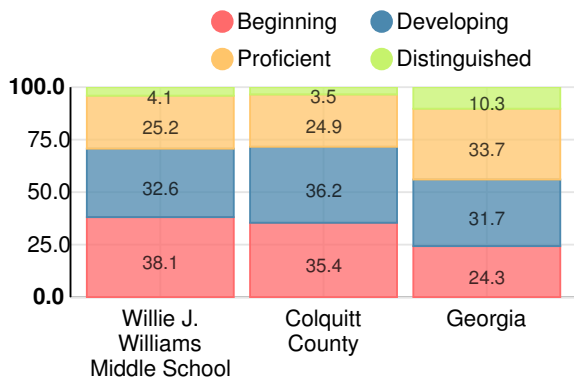

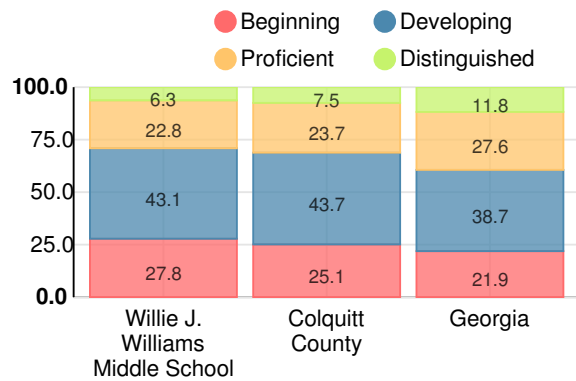

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



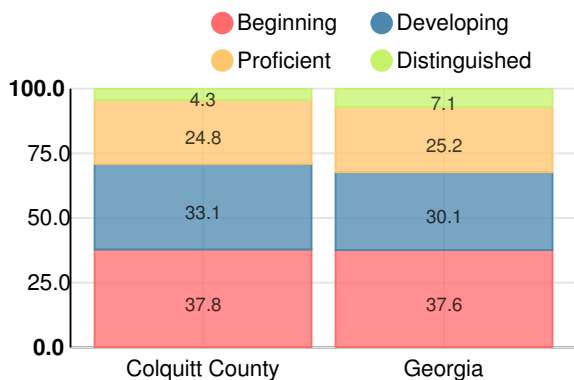

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



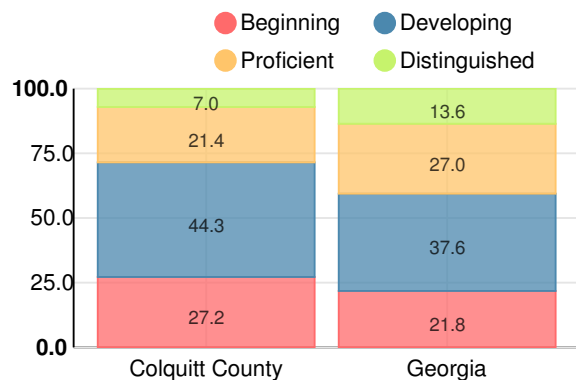
Science
