- 39.1% of its 8th grade students are reading at or above the grade level target.**

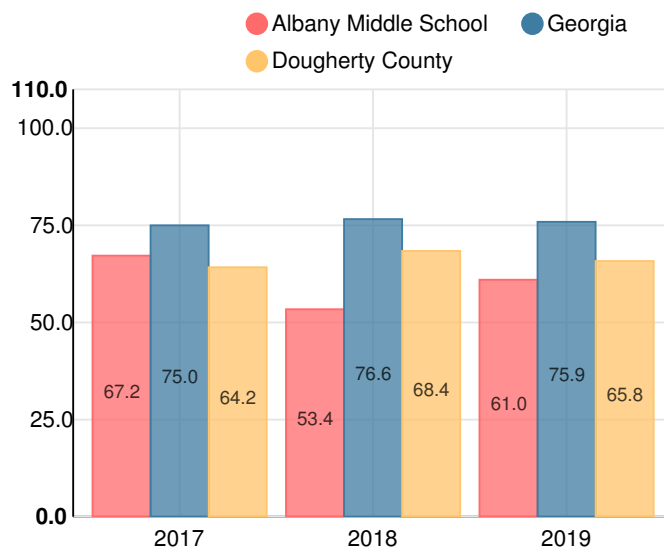

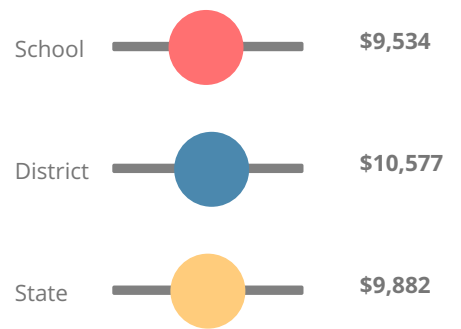

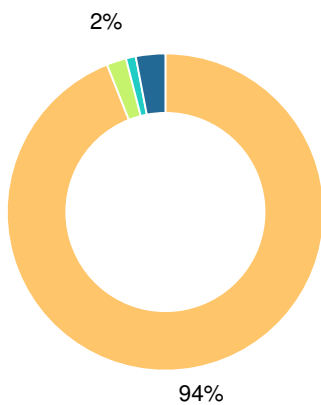


Per Pupil Expenditures



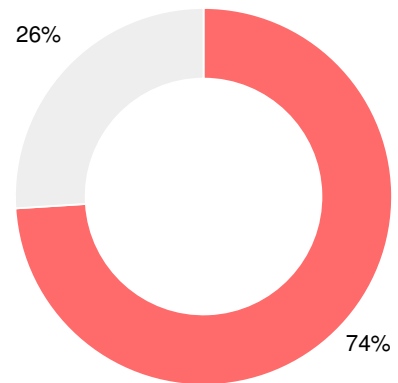

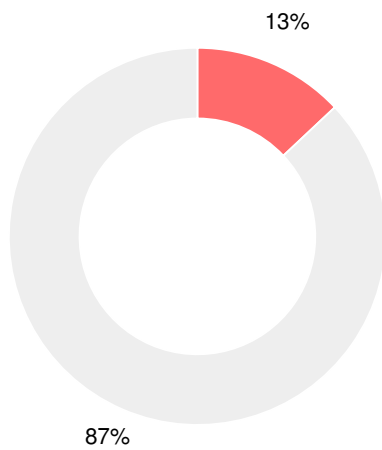

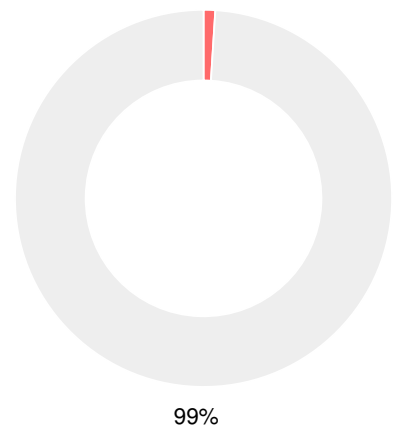

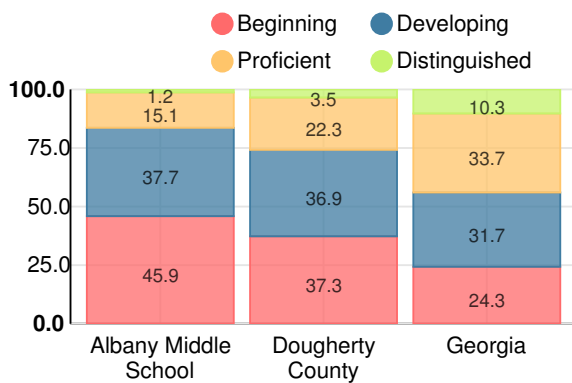

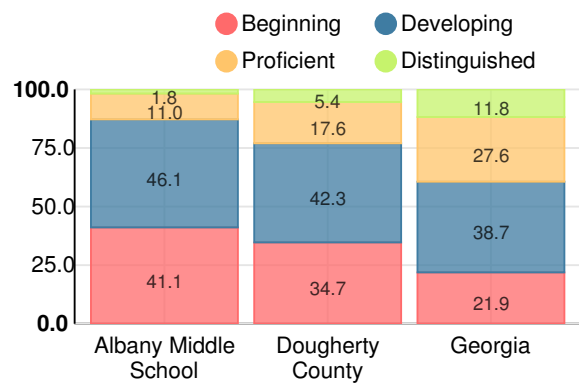

Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



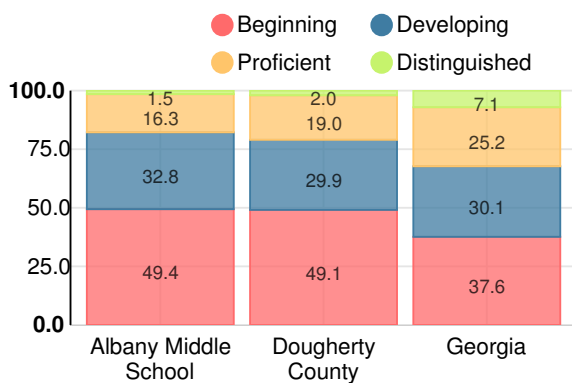

Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



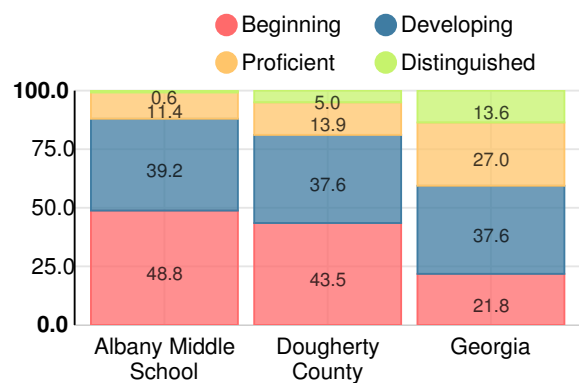
Science
