- **26.1% of its 8th grade students are reading at or above the grade level target**.

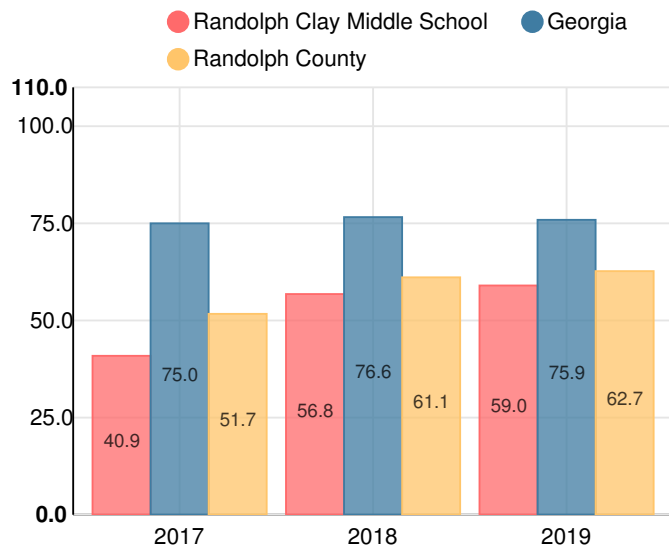

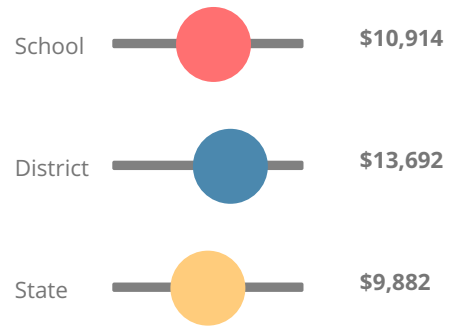

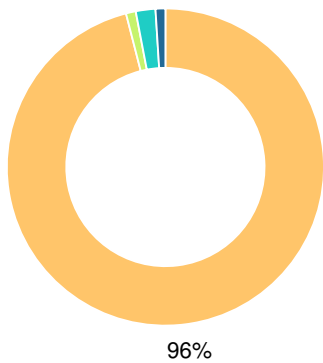


Per Pupil Expenditures

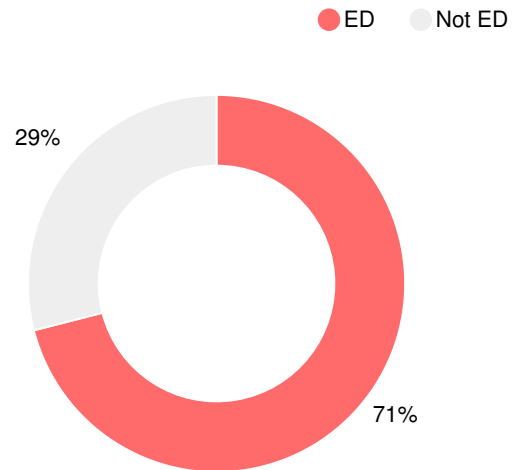

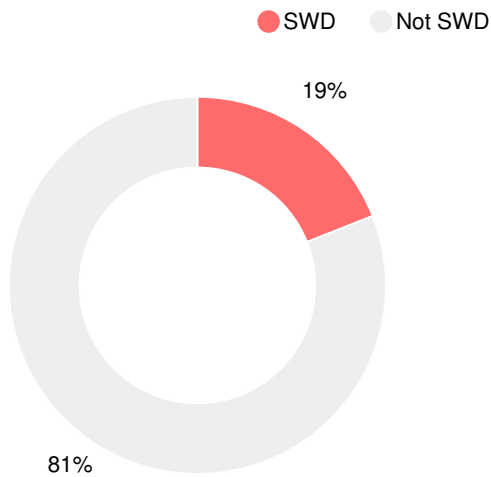

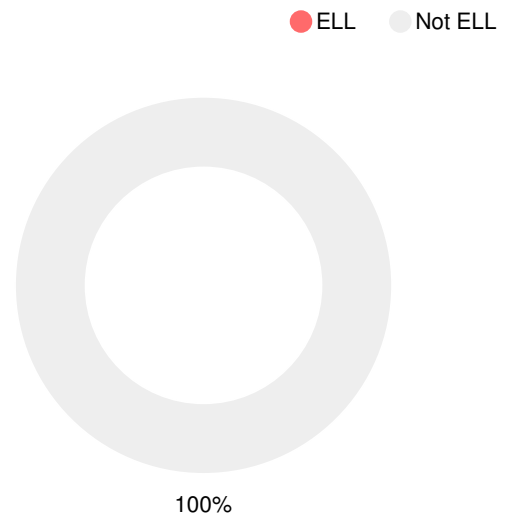

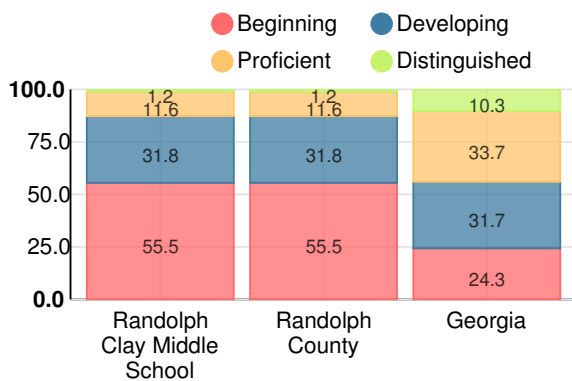

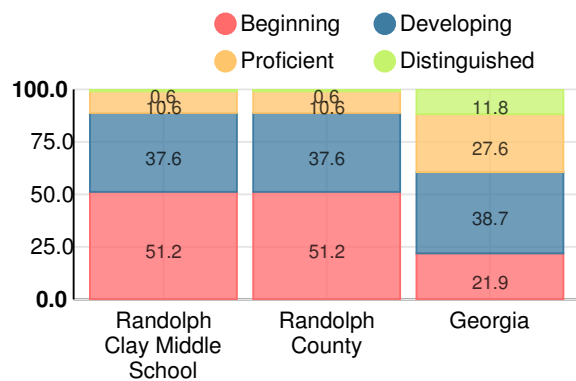

Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



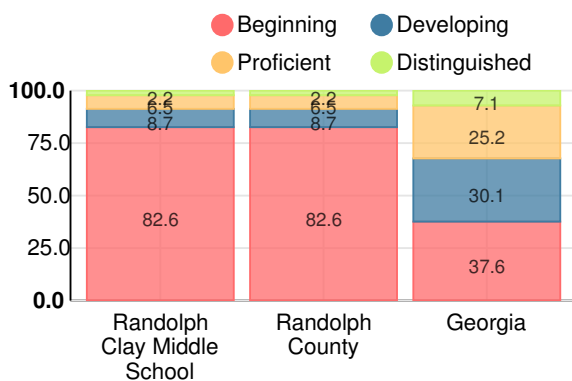
Mathematics

Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



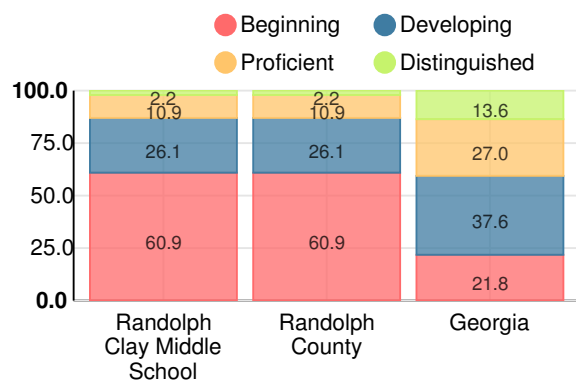
Science
