- Stewart Middle School is **Beating the Odds**, meaning that it performs better than similar schools.

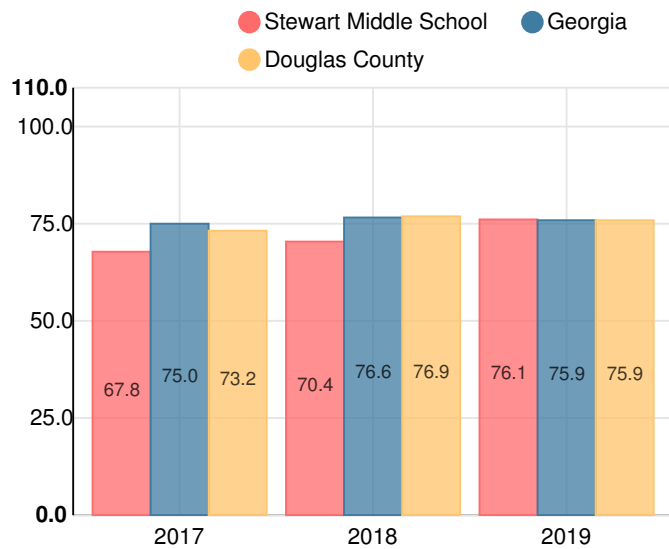

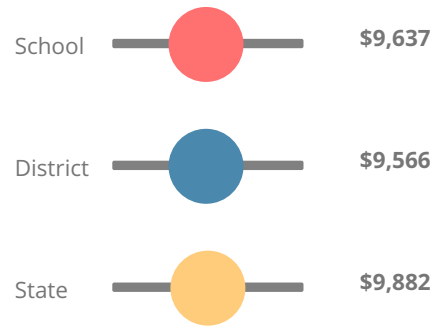
School Climate Star Rating



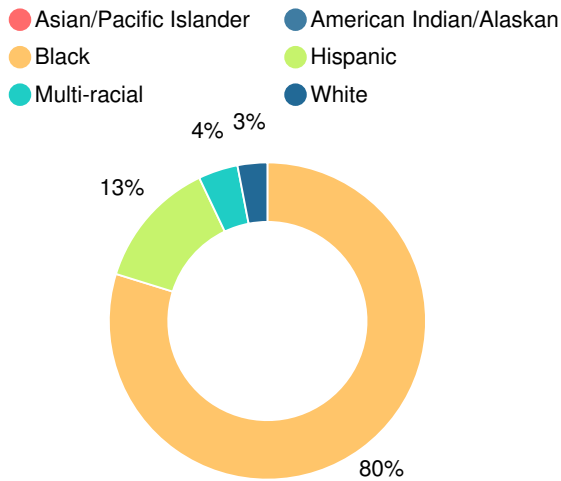
Financial Efficiency Star Rating



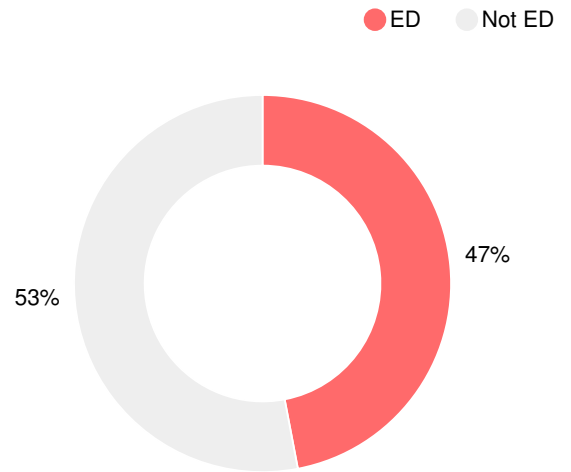
Per Pupil Expenditures



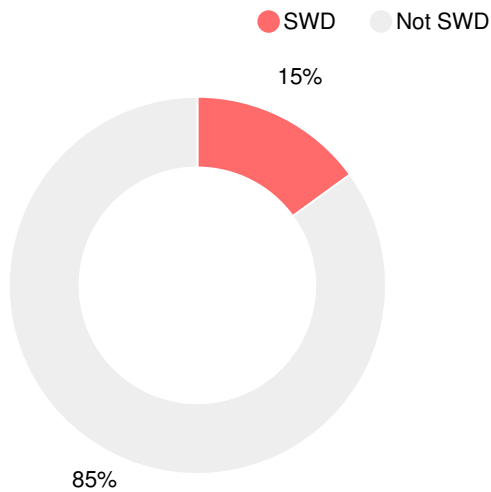

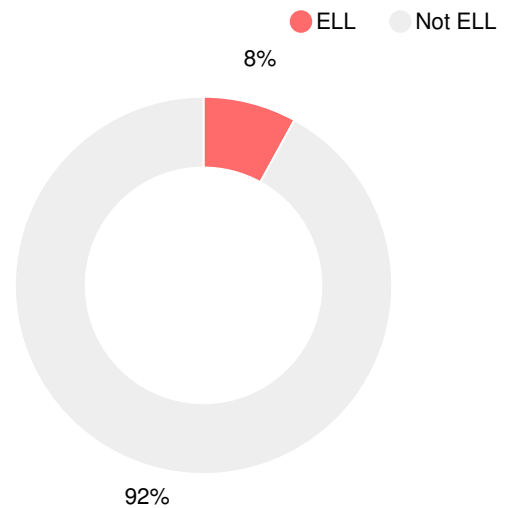

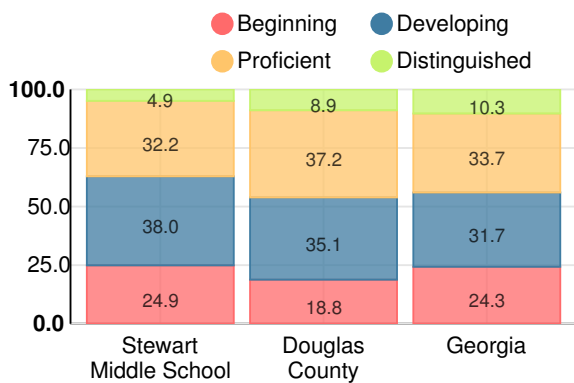

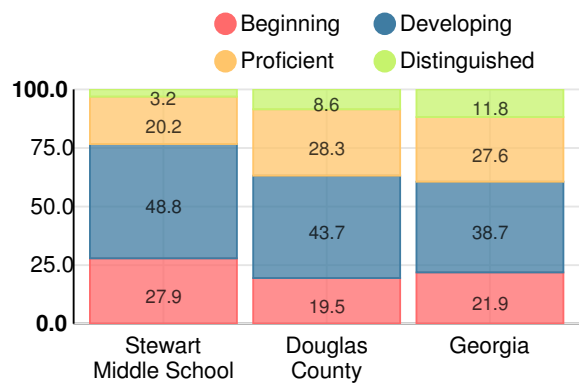

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



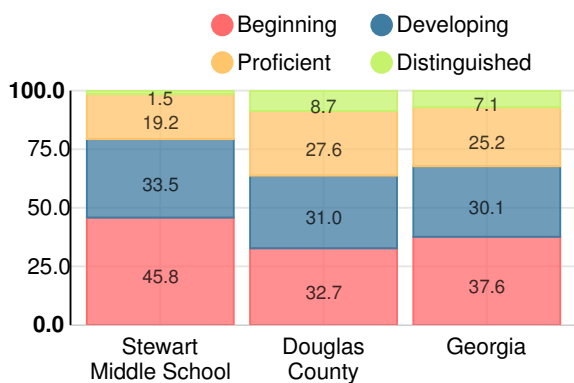
Mathematics

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2019 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



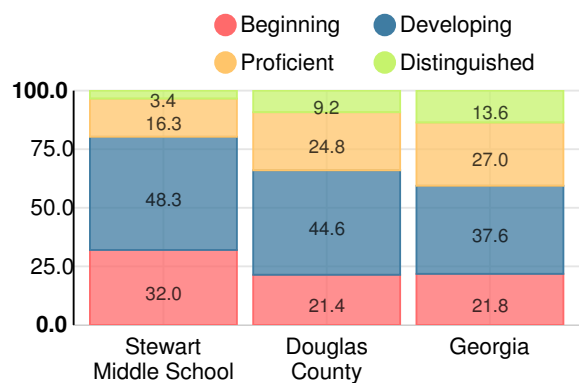
Science
