- **54.6% of its 3rd grade students are reading at or above the grade level target.**

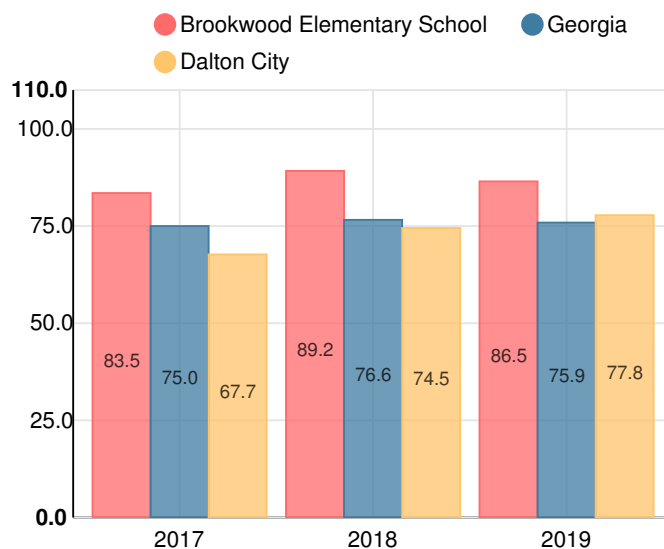

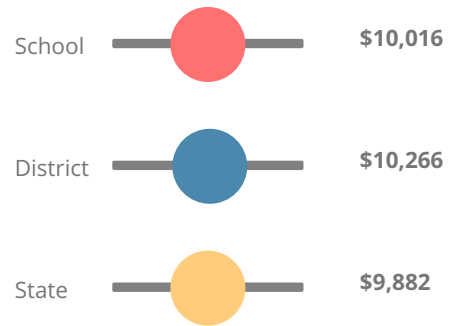

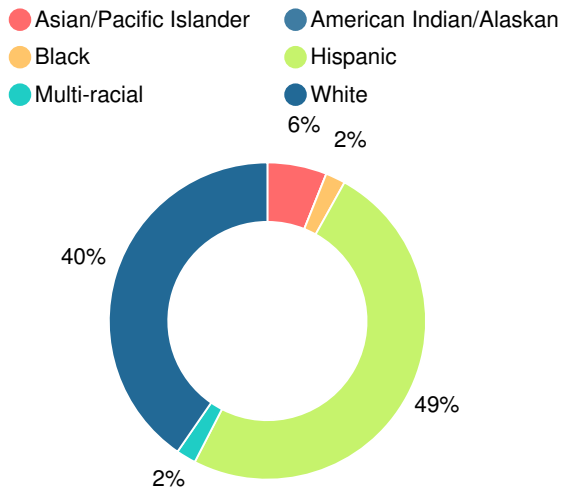
Financial Efficiency Star Rating



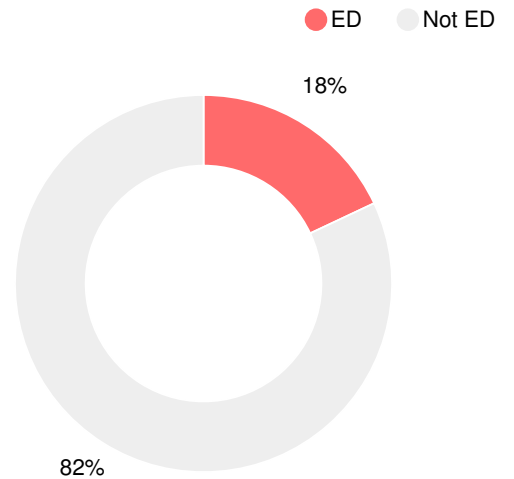
Per Pupil Expenditures



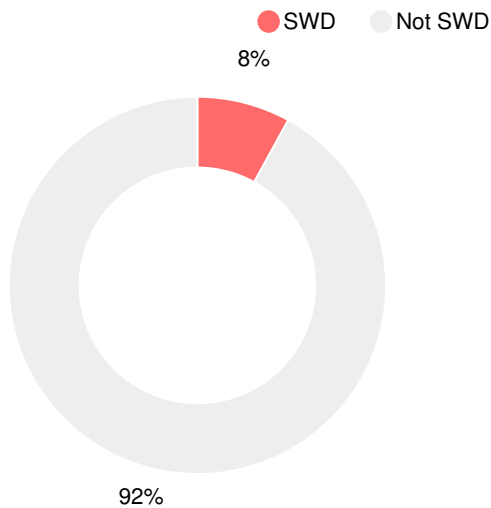

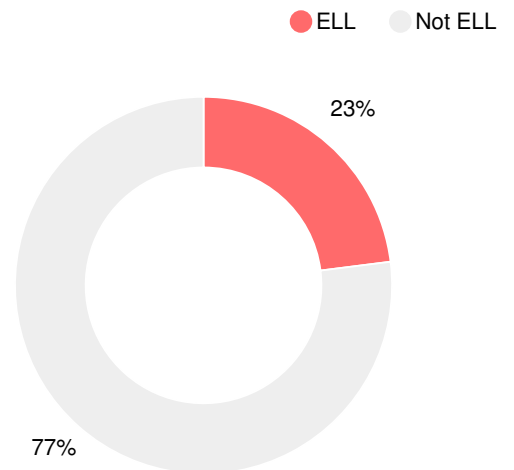

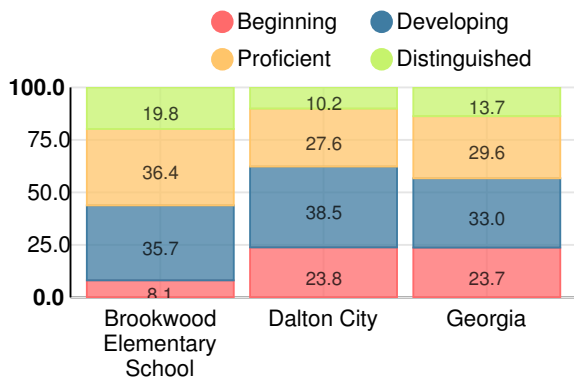

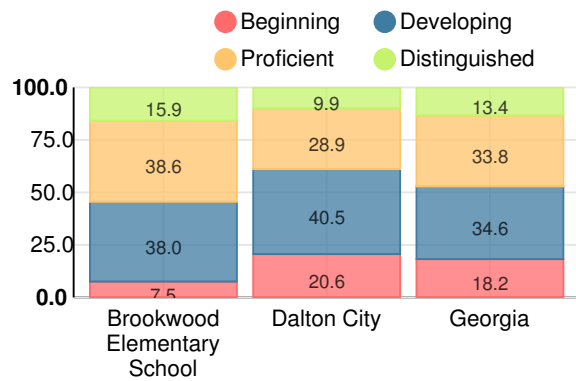

Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



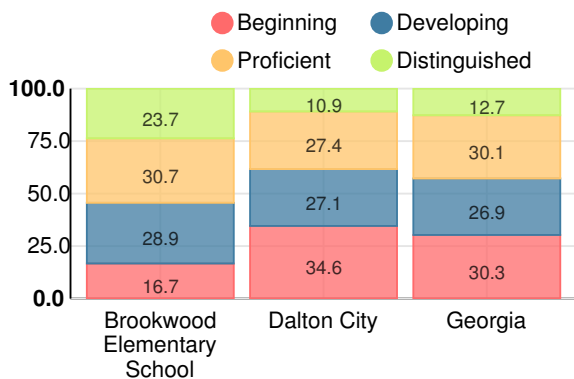

Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



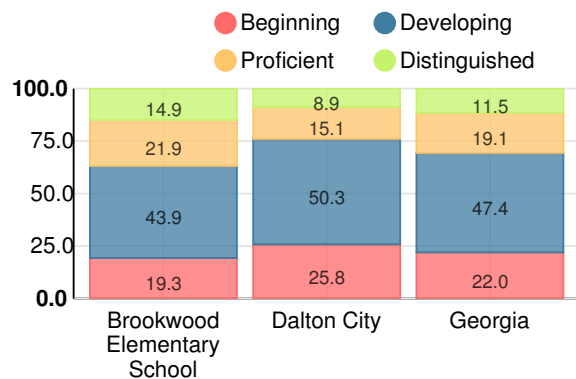

Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



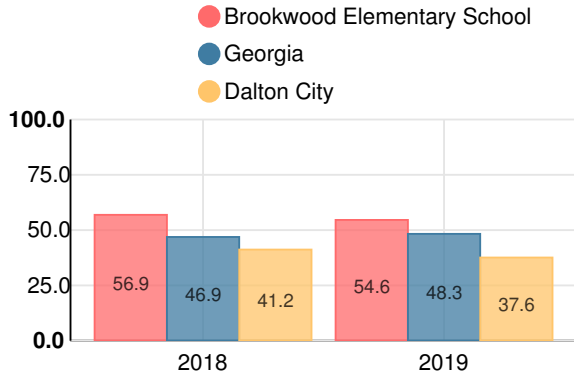
